What is a CPO?

CPO® Certification is sponsored by the National Swimming Pool Foundation (NSPF®), a non-profit organization founded in 1964 to promote education and safety for pool and spa operator. The CPO® Certification course includes a detailed, 16 hour class and an open book examination to prove that he or she has a thorough understanding of practical water chemistry as well as pool and spa operation.

The CPO® Certification is the most recognized pool and spa certification in the United States. It is required by many states, counties, and cities throughout the country. Many Insurance companies offer reduced liability rates to pools that have a CPO® certified staff member.

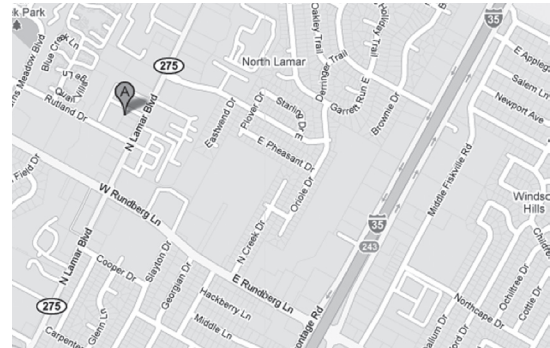
